


Tree = Culture?

- If you did not, how come? Was it because you usually don't see the roots?







- •5 Observers
 - As a group, you will observe the **process** of your group

 - 10 pieces of spaghetti
 - The floor

Builders: Start Building!!!




Tower Building Activity Debrief
