



International Nuclear Safeguards Policy

One-Week Intensive Course & Paid Summer Internships

The Monterey Institute of International Studies in cooperation with Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, and in support of the U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration's Next Generation Safeguards Initiative, is pleased to announce a one-week intensive course on nonproliferation and nuclear safeguards policy in Monterey, CA, and up to six paid summer internships at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory in Livermore, CA.

The International Nuclear Safeguards Policy and Information Analysis Course will be held in Monterey from **May 23–27, 2011**. The course is free for selected participants. A small number of \$500-\$1000 stipends will be available to students outside of the Monterey area to offset transportation and housing costs. Applicants are eligible to compete for a two-month internship from May 31 to August 5, 2011. Interns will receive a monthly \$3000 stipend.

COURSE TOPICS INCLUDE

- The role of international safeguards in the nuclear nonproliferation regime
- Concepts, objectives, and history of international nuclear safeguards
- Negotiation of safeguards agreements
- Case-study analyses of safeguards challenges
- Introduction to material accounting, containment, and surveillance

Applicants must be a currently enrolled graduate student or recent university graduate. Young professionals working in the field of nonproliferation are also encouraged to apply. Selection will be on a competitive basis, based on the merit of the candidates. To be eligible for LLNL internships, applicants must also be U.S. citizens and will be interviewed by a selection panel (over the phone or in person). Interviews will be scheduled shortly after the application deadline.



Application forms are available at <http://cns.miiis.edu> and should be accompanied by an academic transcript, one letter of recommendation, a 500-word statement of purpose, and a current resume. All selections for the course and/or internships will be finalized by April 15, 2011.
