<p>E2E Foundation</p> <p>Mujeres Gestores de Paz</p>	<p>Mujeres Gestores de Paz is an E2E project focused on the creation of a workshop to reintegrate displaced women and women affected by the war, into civilian life with new meaning and purpose. Storytelling and group activities will be used to create dialogue among women where they can discuss and reflect on their experiences. Through a gender rights and equality framework, they will have to opportunity to re-establish their identities as women in Colombian society. The project will provide women with the support they need to recover and reintegrate into society, while also helping the Colombian government to achieve national and international reparations goals post-conflict.</p> <p>The goal is to design a workshop to understand the needs of women in the context of reparations, reconciliation and reintegration efforts. By designing a successful workshop, the hope is that the content can become a launching point for developing strategic lines of intervention to better attend women's' needs and develop sustainable solutions.</p> <p>This project would entail assisting in the design process of this workshop. A representative from the urban zone, Comuna 8, will be present for the workshop and active in its design process.</p>

Inventopolis is developing new methodologies that specifically target adolescent illiteracy for older children. E2E/Corporacion Campo Santo/Chef Pedro Fernandez Desarrollo de modelo de negocios para unidades productivas	<p>Several successfully urban gardens are operating in the urban area of Medellín. In particular, there has been much success in reintegration programs linked to urban gardens. Cerro de los Valores in la Comuna 8 is an example of how a productive urban garden can contribute not only to poverty reduction by generating job opportunities in the hillside communities of Medellín, but also to the process of reintegration, reconciliation and peacebuilding.</p> <p>One of the main challenges hindering the impact of urban gardens is a lack of access to viable markets and a stable demand for the products they produce.</p> <p>The basis of the project is to create a brand of sauces created by Pedro Fernández, to market in Colombia and the United States with products grown by the populations mentioned above. The project seeks to ensure a stable demand for the productive units of growers, and thus a stable income that contributes to the development of communities.</p> <p>This pilot project, which will begin with Corporación Campo Santo in Cerro de los Valores, aims to close this gap, creating a link between entrepreneur and chef Pedro Fernández, and urban cultivator communities in Medellín.</p>
